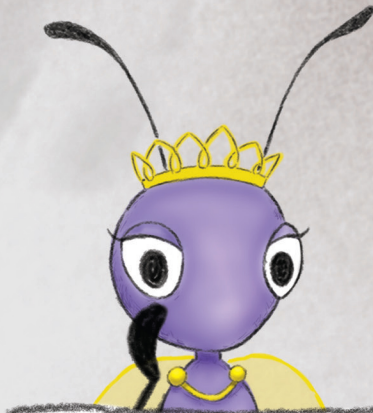

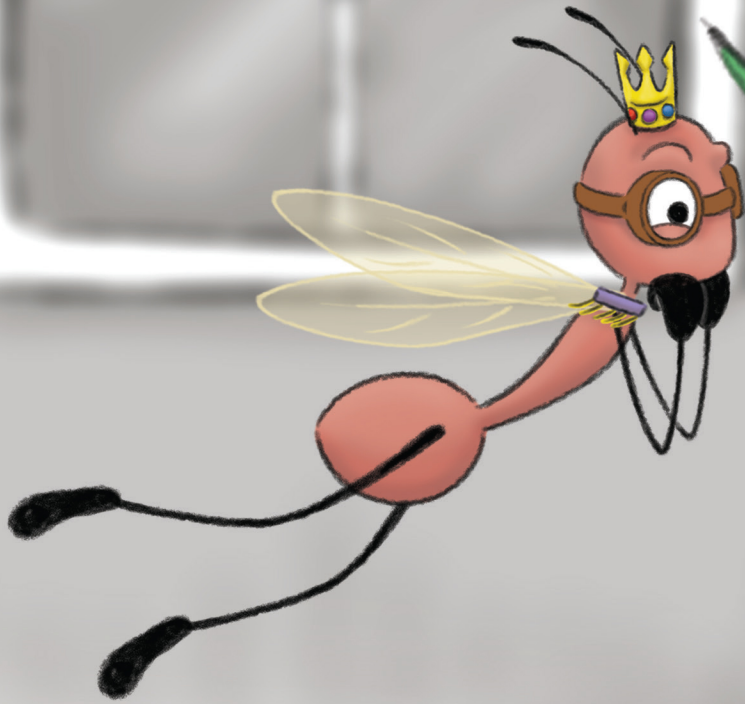

The early morning sun shines brightly on the Bakers' house that sits on a nice little street in a nice little neighborhood.



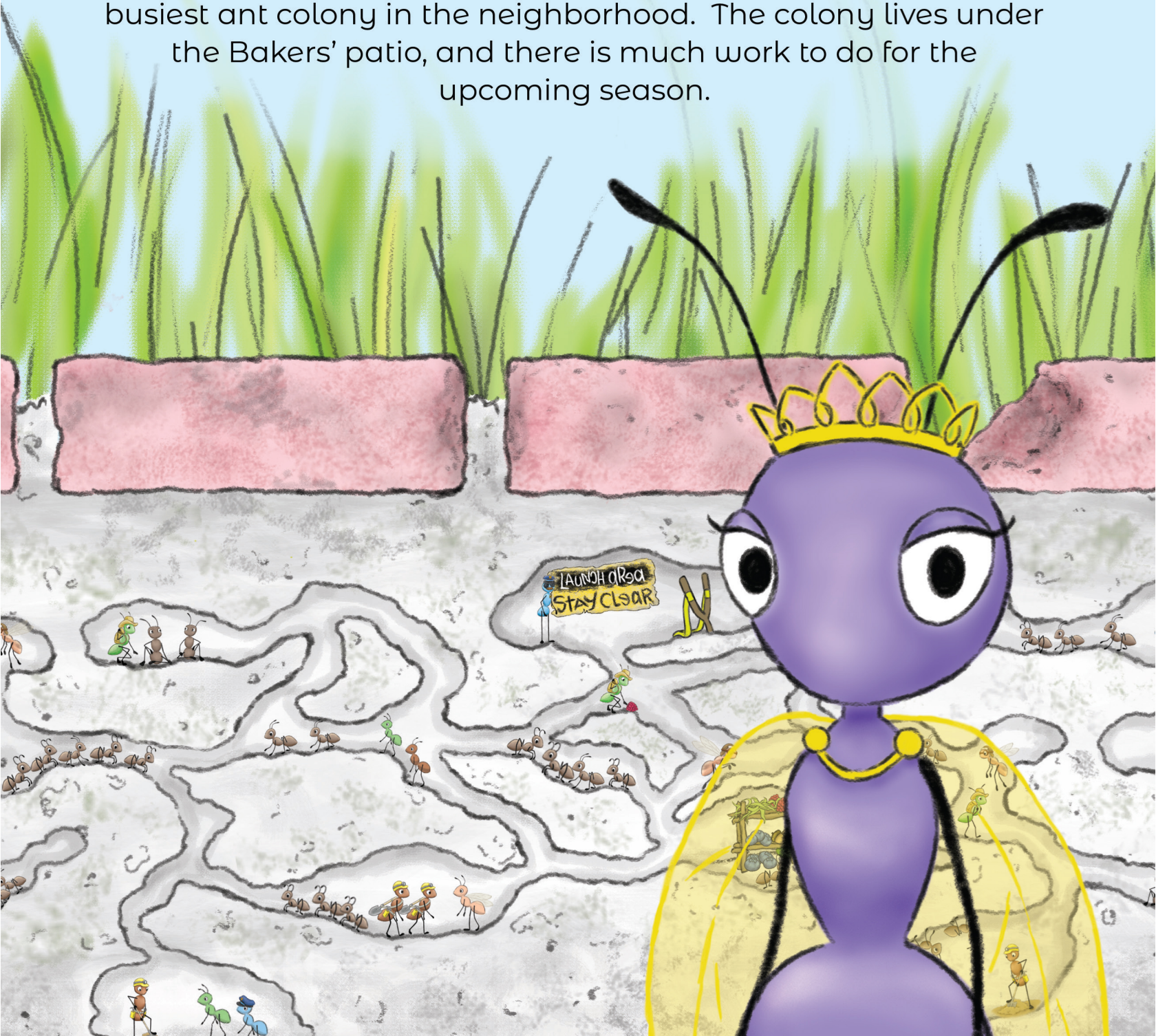
Recent rain showers combined with warmer spring temperatures have brought bright colors to the grass and garden of the Bakers' patio.
